Annual Membership**

Annual Membership

Renewal for Annual Membership will be at the Company’s sole discretion, Membership will only commence upon payment in full of the annual subscription. The current membership categories and price list is available from the Golf Shop and is stated on the Club website. The annual subscriptions are set by the company (LLI) and sent via email from the January prior to the renewal date of April 1st. Those members without email can request a posted renewal being sent to them.

If paying by Direct Debit the member is financing their membership subscription with an external finance company this being Premium Credit (Fairway Credit). By committing to pay by direct debit the member is agreeing to fulfil all agreed payments until the end of the current membership year March 31st. The annual renewal process commences January each year and at this time the member may notify the Club in writing that he or she wishes not to renew their Membership for the following year and must of course contact Fairway Credit to cancel their agreement with them also. This is the responsibility of the member not LLI as the finance agreement is with Premium Credit not LLI.

New Member Application

Acceptance for Membership to Test Valley will be at the Company’s sole discretion. Upon joining the new members’ application form must be properly completed and membership will only commence upon payment of the relevant subscription fee as agreed at the time of joining. Membership will not be possible if the new member has convictions in relation to child safeguarding concerns.

Termination or Suspension of Membership

The Company reserves the right to cancel or suspend Membership at any time in the following circumstances;

1. If any subscription fees are not paid by a date agreed by the company
2. Serious or repeated breaches of the Membership Terms & Conditions, Club Byelaws & Players Code of Conduct.
3. If a member has convictions relating to child safeguarding concerns

The member may apply to suspend their membership due to serious ill health upon production of a Doctor’s letter stating the member to be unfit to play golf.

Suspension of membership may be for a period of 6 months, a longer period of time is at the discretion of the general manager, whose decision will be final.

Any suspension of membership period agreed will be applied to the next annual renewal period.

Suspension of membership will not be given for long periods of holiday.

It is company policy not to give refunds for membership monies paid.

The Club’s Byelaws & Players Code of Conduct are set out separately and are displayed on the Club’s website members area. Members and their guests are respectfully asked to make their selves aware of the contents to ensure that everyone’s time experienced at Test Valley is an enjoyable one.

Members Health

Each member accepts Membership on the condition that it is their responsibility to obtain proper medical advice at all times with regard to any exercise intended to be carried out at the Club. Each member must make the general manager aware of any serious medical condition that staff should be aware of. The company reserves the right to cancel membership to the course based on it being unsafe for the member concerned.
